

Body transfer authorization

The authorization to transfer the body allows the repatriation of the body, for burial in Algeria, of an Algerian national who died in Denmark and whose identity and Algerian nationality are confirmed.

This document is essential for the admission to Algeria of the remains.

The body transfer takes place in the following ways:

The funeral home organization chosen by the family takes the necessary steps to put together the file to be provided to the consulate, to obtain authorization to transfer the body.

This file consists of the following original documents:

- * A full copy of the death certificate
- * The burial permit issued by the town hall services.
- * The brewing report drawn up by the funeral services
- * The prefectural authorization (mortuary pass) issued by the prefecture services
- * A medical certificate of non-contagion issued by the Danish health services.
- * The air waybill (LTA. Failing this, an information sheet including flight details and place of burial.
- * Stamp duties (0.40 euros)

Funeral directors can send the transfer file by email to transfer-body @ ambalg copenhagen-algerie.com, Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The original documents must be presented upon withdrawal of the body transfer authorization.

In the absence of the family in Denmark, the Embassy is empowered to take all steps necessary for the repatriation of the deceased when the latter is duly identified, covered by funeral insurance, supported by his family in Algeria or in possession of " a bank account to cover repatriation costs.

For people of foreign nationality, who, during their lifetime, expressed the wish to be buried in Algeria, the agreement of the commune (A.P.C) for burial in Algeria is necessary.
